CHAIRMAN LAUNCHES NEW 5 YEAR WATER PLAN PROCESS

Chairman, Leonie Burrows, has today announced the new Water Plan 3 (2013 to 2018) process commencement for Lower Murray Water (LMW).

“The Water Plan sets out the proposed service outcomes LMW will deliver, the operating and capital expenditure and forward looking estimates of revenue to deliver services for the period between 2013 to 2018. It is authorised by the Essential Services Commission and will detail what prices and tariff structures we, as the regional water provider, will be charging.” said Mrs Burrows.

“As an essential part of this process, we will be seeking customer, community and broader stakeholder input into what people would like to see as the services provided in the region in the future.”

“To gain this feedback we will be having varying types of community consultation to ensure we receive a range of views and opinions about water, sewerage, irrigation and drainage issues.”

“Water in our region is such an important natural resource and we know that our customers and the broader community are very passionate about water so we expect some ‘spirited’ input.”

Lower Murray Water will be releasing information about their Water Plan over the coming weeks via their website and will have open meetings with the community to seek views.
