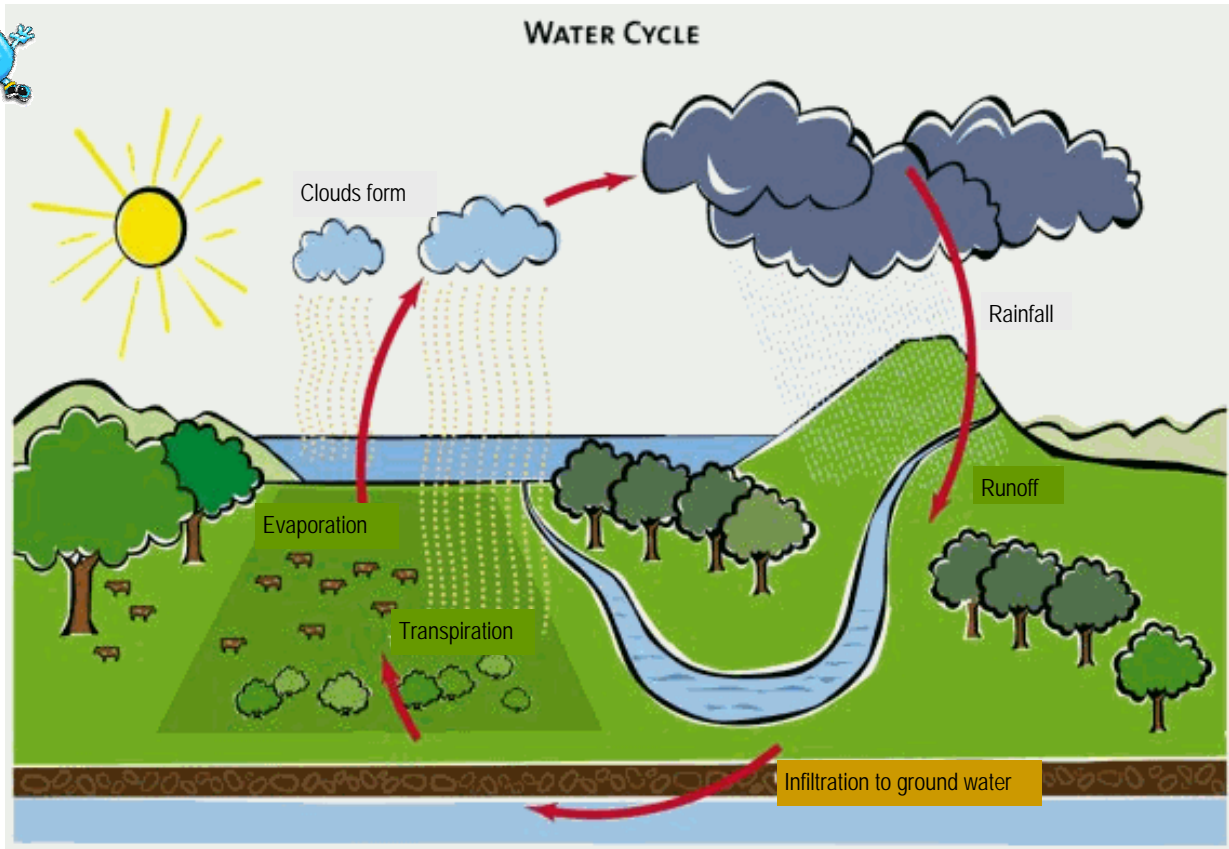


Do you know where the water comes from before it reaches the tap – the sun and the rain give us water. The process is called the “Water Cycle”, it is also called the “Hydrological Cycle”



## Can you answer the following questions about the Water Cycle?

HINT: the picture above could help you

- Water comes from the clouds as RA..... Water can leave the ground by EVA..... or by TRA..... Can you think of two places the water goes when it rains? Into the GRO....., into the RIV.....
- Is GROUND WATER on top of the ground, or below it? .....
- Did you know that water can have many *forms*—it can be a LIQUID (eg: water from the tap); or a SOLID (eg: frozen water; ice or snow) and it can also be a GAS (eg: steam from a boiling kettle). What *form* do you think water is if it is:
1. RAIN .....
  2. EVAPORATION.....
  3. SNOW.....
  4. HAIL.....
  5. RUNOFF.....
  6. TRANSPIRATION.....
  7. FLOWING IN THE RIVER.....
- Why do you think it is called the Water Cycle? .....

When you've found all the words that rhyme with RAIN, make up a song about water and rain, using as many of the words as you can

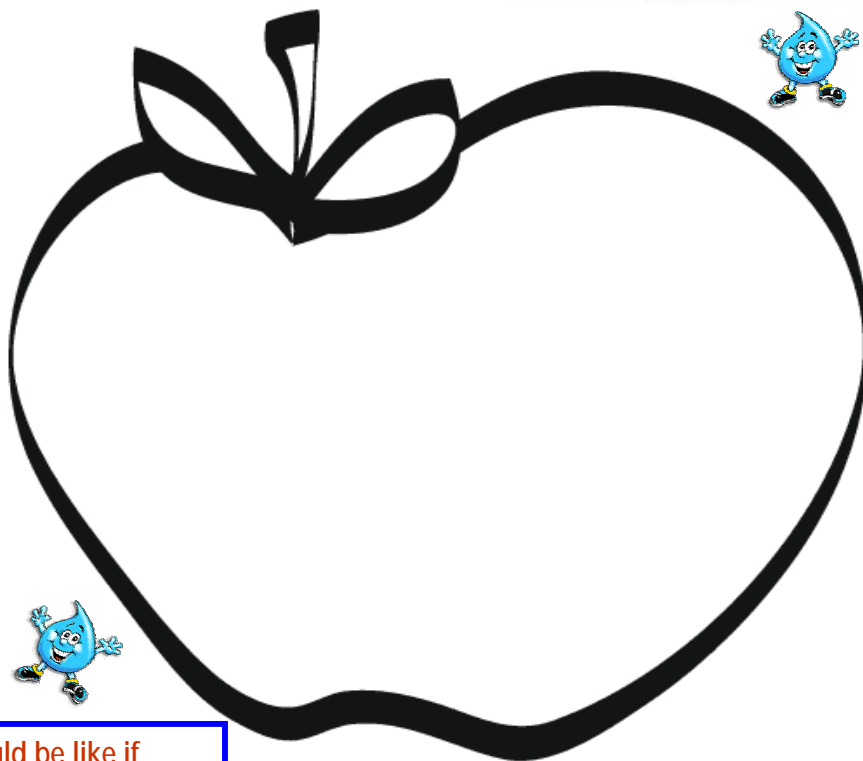
# Being WaterWise is a Winner!
