Payment

Accounts can be delivered electronically via BPAY View. Log into your online banking and look for the BPAY View or View Bills section to register each account. Your next account will be automatically sent to your online banking account.

Concession

From 1 July 2020 the maximum Water concession cap will be **\$168.55**.

Recipients of eligible Centrelink or Department of Veterans Affairs concession cards may be entitled to a concession on Irrigation Districts Domestic and Stock Supply Charges. Conditions apply. Details are available from our office.

Due Dates for Payment

Mailing Date – October 2020

Due Date – end November 2020

All Rural tariffs and charges must be paid by the date specified in the invoice provided and failing any date being specified in that invoice, 28 clear days from the date of issue of the invoice.

The date on all invoices/accounts represents the final date that the payment will be accepted interest free.

Interest shall be payable in respect to all amounts payable under a tariff or charge if the amount is not paid by the due date. From 1 July 2020 the interest rate has been set by the Essential Services Commission and the determined rate will apply for the entire financial year.
