- ¹ *E.coli* is a bacterial indicator of faecal contamination and is found in the gut of humans and animals.
- ² Turbidity is a measure of the clarity of the water. It is affected by the presence of suspended material in the water. *Rolling 12 month 95% UCL of mean.
- ³ Trihalomethanes are disinfection by products formed when chlorine reacts with naturally occurring organic matter in the water.
